1. Congressman Tom Cole R-OK \$2,700

Tom is on the appropriations committee and a very strong supporter. He has been helpful in passing the Congressional Reference and as a member of the Chickasaw Tribe he knows Indian issues well. He is a good friend, as well.

2. Congressman Bruce Westerman, R-AR \$1,000

3. Senator Roy Blunt, R-MO \$1,000
