Tribal Spotlight



Driving on Downstream Boulevard towards the casino, guests are welcomed by the Quapaw Tribal Flag. The tribal flag was developed in the late 1970's by the past Tribal Business Manager Lloyd Buffalo, Secretary-Bookkeeper Barbara Kyser-Collier and tribal member Walter King, Jr. The first copy was drawn out on cardboard by Kyser-Collier then later the picture was transferred to canvas flags which were hand painted, by local artist John Fitzgibbon.

Just like Downstream Casino, the tribal flag depicts generations of Quapaw history. The red and blue background of the flag reflect the colors that are in a French trade broad cloth; a wool fabric that was used for blankets and clothing, which were worn often times in the Native American Church. The eagle feathers pay respect to the eagle, the sacred bird that flies the highest and can communicate with Wah-Kah-Da; there are four representing the four directions. Eagle feathers were also used within the Native American Church meetings and many other tribal ceremonies. The buffalo supports the survival of the Quapaw people, who used the skins for clothing and shelter, the meat for food, with the remaining portion for tools, weapons and armor.

The word O-Gah-Pah is how the Quapaw people say "Quapaw" in their language, and is translated to mean downstream people.

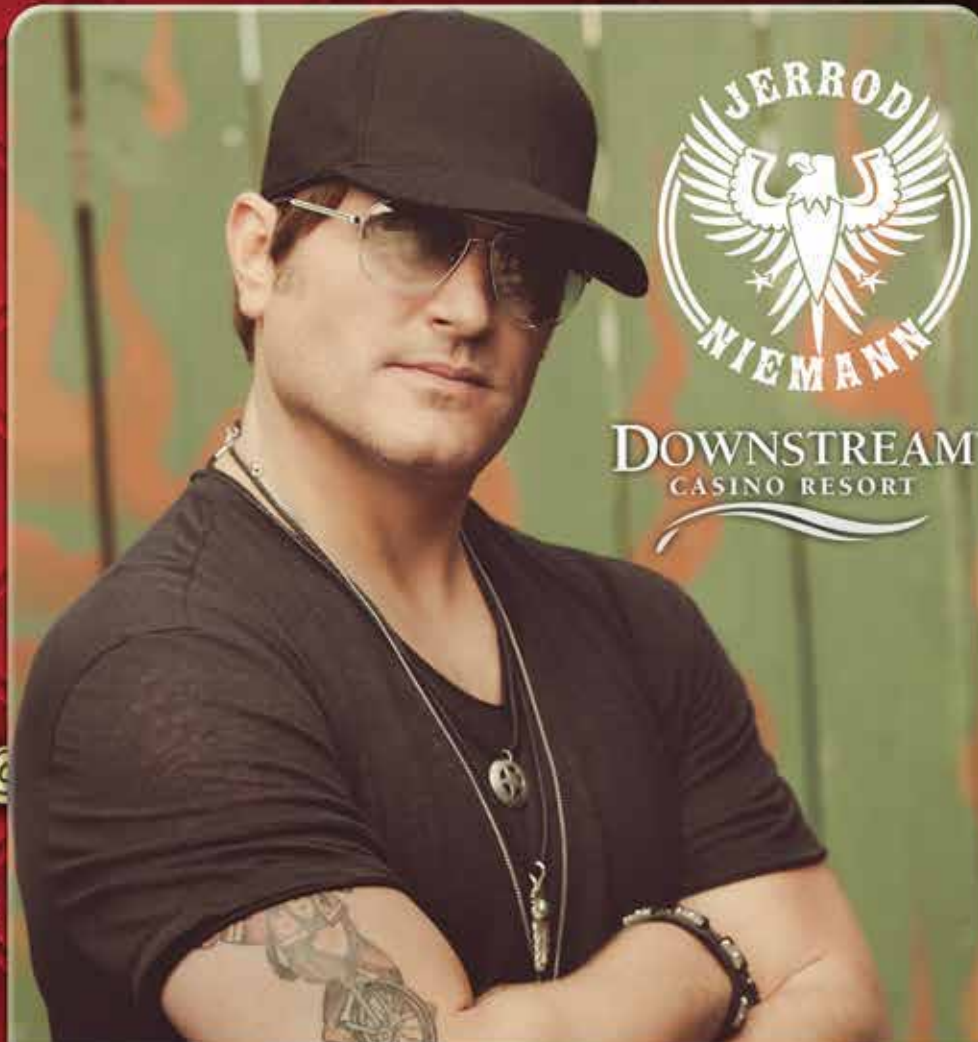

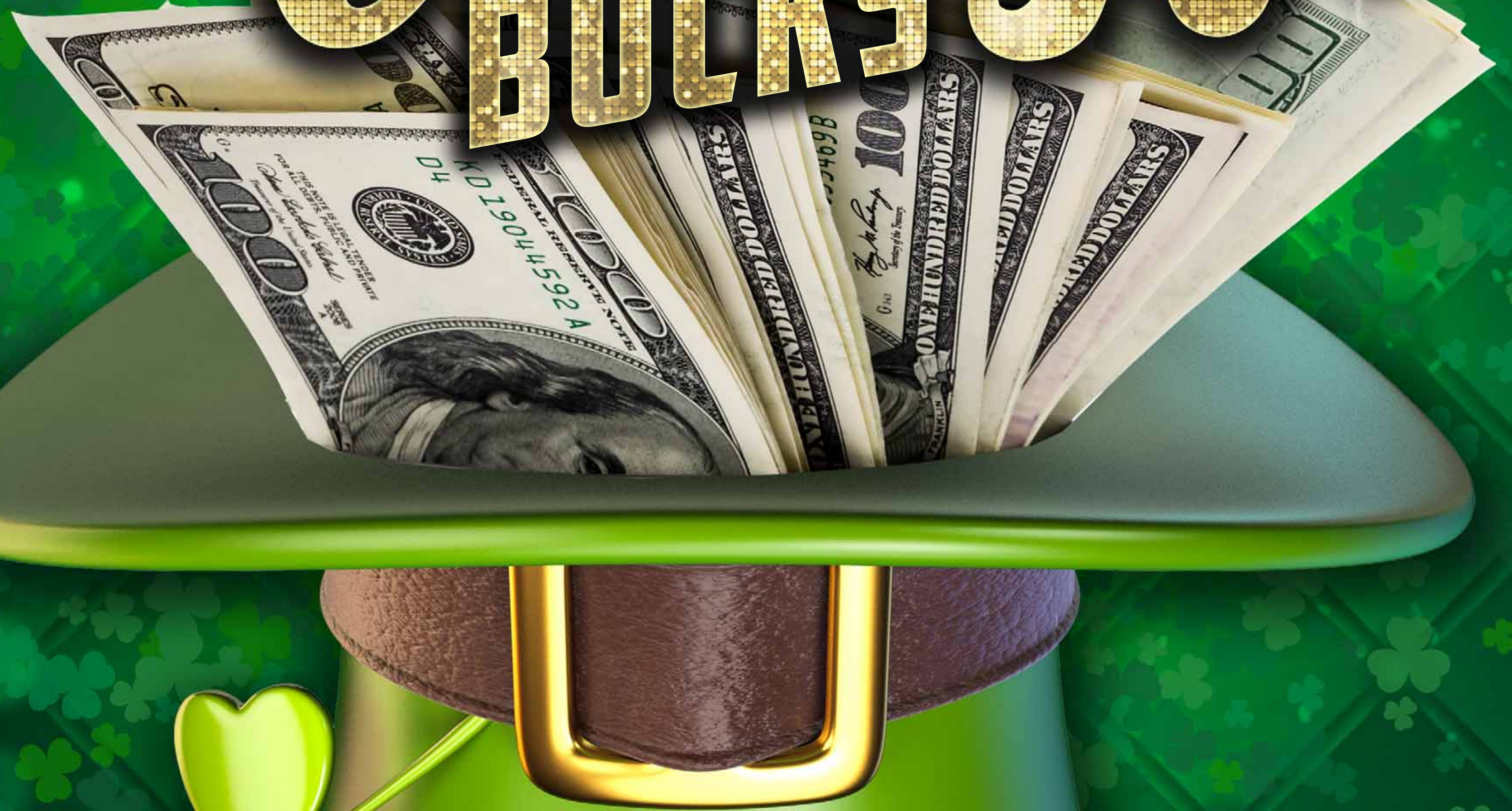

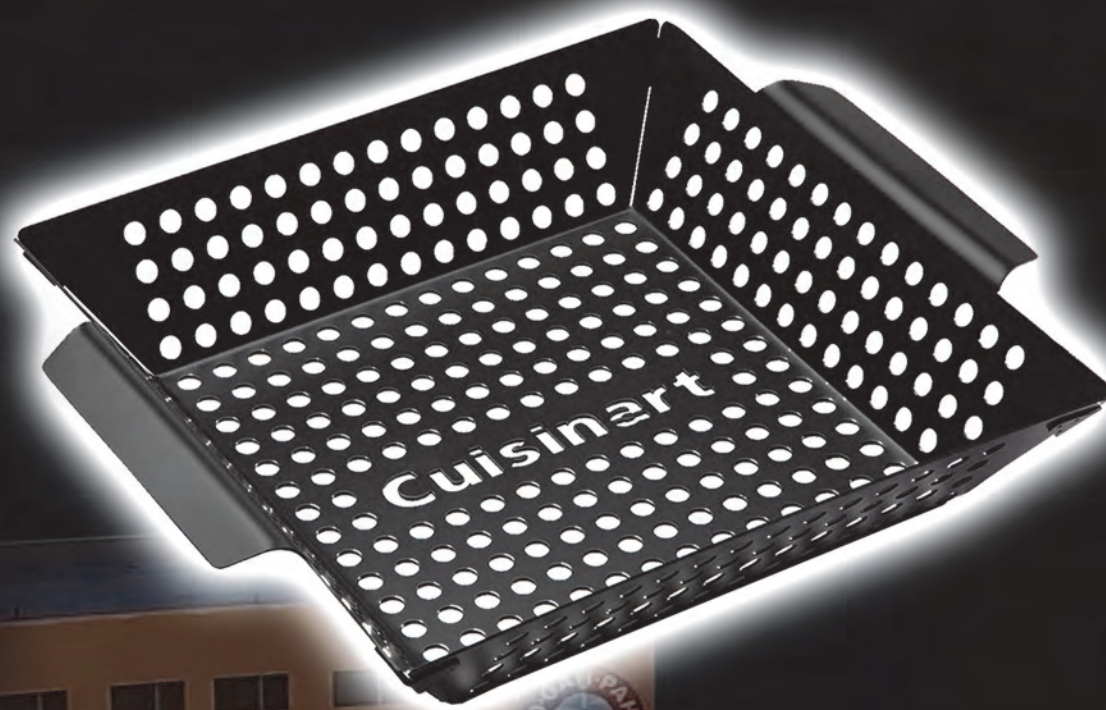
