1st Quarter Table Games Review

- October 7th, 2010 new pay rates were implemented in the Department.
- Approximately 30 new Dual-Rate Supervisors were promoted.
- Schedules were set for a 70/30 ratio as far as Dealing shifts to Supervisor shifts for Dual Rates.
- Our Hourly payroll expense was about 100k below 1st Quarter budgeted amount and about 50k less in hard cost then 1st quarter 2010.
- .25 cents per hour dealer contribution with 100% company match program was instituted for additional Dual/Rate floor pay.
- Recently posted for 3 Fulltime supervisors. Should have interviews and positions filled before January 28th.
- Re-alignment of tables on the floor was planned, approved and completed for January 18th, 2011. This included:
 - o Removal of Card Craps
 - o The addition of 2 more INBet side bet Blackjack games in order to create additional revenue.
 - The addition of a much needed additional Blackjack table in Pit 1.
- New product has been looked at for our mix such as:
 - o Additional side bet Blackjack games.
 - o 3CP Progressive (which means a side bet for 3CP).
- We currently have 209 gaming positions on the floor with:
 - o 113 fulltime Team members.
 - o 28 Part time Team members.
