John, OIEC had requested \$20,000 to fight Empire's latest rate case before the Oklahoma Corporation. They were asking the Commission to allow them to shut down their Asbury plant and begin to purchase wind energy to replace the power generated at Asbury. This was probably being done due to the low cost of gas generation of electric as opposed to coal and not because they wanted to begin using wind. This effort comes on the heels of Empire completing the \$200 plus million upgrades to the coal plant.

OEIC estimated that Downstream's increase if this request were approved by the Corporation Commission would be in the range of \$300,000 a year. For Downstream to participate, based on the casino's usage, it would costs \$20,000 to join in the effort to oppose Empire's rate case. I pointed out to Tom that without Downstream's help last time they would not have been as successful as they were. He adjusted their offer down to \$12,000.

I worked at getting J&M Farms to join and have been working on 3M as well. Also trying to get some others involved to help lower the costs. They I believe they would do this for a commitment of \$10,000. I will continue to help in securing additional participation from local businesses to help lower costs.
